Sir / Madam,

With reference to the above and the discussion held during the Principals' Conference held from 18th to 20th July, 2011, it is to inform that in order to have good number of exhibits on variety of sub-themes, it is decided to allot themes to different clusters. It will also help to avoid duplication of exhibits as in the past. It is observed that children bring many exhibits on certain themes and none are found on some other theme. The dates of Cluster, Regional & National Level Exhibitions and venue for Regional & National Level Exhibition, 2011 is given below for your information and necessary action:-

DATES :-

1. Vidyalaya Level Competition to be completed by 1st week of September,2011
2. Cluster Level Competition will be held on 29th & 30th Sept. 2011.
3. Regional Level Competition will be held on 4th & 5th November 2011.
4. National Level Competition will be held from 8th & 9th November 2011.

VENUES :

1. The Cluster venues are given below.
2. The Regional Level Venue is KV No.3, Bhubaneswar.
3. The National Level Venue is KV Aliganj, Lucknow.

STAY ARRANGEMENTS:-

1. For Regional Level Competition, the stay will be arranged in KV-3 Bhubaneswar itself.
2. For National Level Competition to be held at Lucknow – Stay Venue will be KVs of Lucknow.

You are requested to encourage the students to prepare exhibits on the areas allotted to them. All guidance and support should be extended from Vidyalaya side. This should be done as per the recognized clusters:-

The Venue KVs will not participate in their own schools. The following arrangement will be followed:

1. KV Berhampur will go to KV-2 Bhubaneswar
2. KV-2 Bhubaneswar will go to KV Bondamunda
3. KV Bondamunda will go to KV-2 Bhubaneswar
4. KV Namkum will go to KV-1 Bokaro
5. KV-1 Bokaro will go to KV Namkum, Ranchi

IMPORTANT NOTE :

The children of Bhubaneswar Region will present dance **only from PHILIPINES as decided by KVS(HQ)**. Hence, Principals should make all efforts to train children for an excellent performance.

The Regional contingent shall comprise of maximum 32 students. The Regional contingent shall be escorted by a maximum of 03 teachers (one language teacher/ other subjects, one music teacher and one teacher with Humanities background, atleast one of these must be a lady teacher), one Group D (Sub-staff) employee who should be a male, who can help in arranging exhibits and making small electrical connections etc. The regional contingent will reach the venue latest by the afternoon of 7th November, 2011. The exhibits will be arranged by 7th November, 2011 (A/N) so that exhibition scheduled for 8th November, 2011 morning does not get delayed. The return journey should not be planned before 8.30 pm of 9th November, 2011.

The exhibits will remain on display till afternoon of 9th November, 2011 so that minimum 200 students from neighboring KVs of Lucknow Region may be allowed to see the exhibits to inculcate a national perspective.

DEBATE –

The topic for English/Hindi debates has already been intimated vide our letter under reference.

Each region will sponsor two speakers one ‘for’ and the other ‘against’ the motion separately for Hindi and English. The debate will be of 05 minute duration of which minimum 01 minute MUST BE (repeat must be) devoted to rebuttal and repartee. The first two speakers; one for and the other against the motion will be given only four minutes and one minute at the end for their share of rebuttal and repartee. The first Speaker speaking for the motion will be given one minute for rebuttal after all the speakers spoke. The division of marks for the debate will be as follows:

Content	-	30
Presentation	-	40
Rebuttal & Repartee	-	30 (No marks will be allowed if rebuttal part is left untouched)

(Logic, thought, process, pronunciation, flavor, confidence)

The aim of the exercise is to discourage cramming and to encourage spontaneous speaking.

Group Dance

Group Dance to be presented by the Region must be related to the State/Country allotted to the Region. Maximum time allowed for the dance will be 06 (six) minutes including the announcement. Number of participants allowed on the stage will be six to eight besides six persons including the Music Teacher for background music and song. No person from outside KV will be allowed to play/sing. Pre-recorded cassette or any other recorded device will not be allowed. The group dance being presented will be performed in the costume of the Place/State concerned. Marks allotted for dance are detailed below:-

Group Song

Duration of the Group Song will be 4-5 minute including the announcement. The number of participants allowed on the stage will be 6-8 with 04 persons including the Music Teacher for background music. The group song may be in Hindi or in the language of the State/Country allotted to the Region. The theme of the song may be patriotism, national integration. Social Cohesion, Youth/women empowerment or the folklores of the State/Country. The division of marks will be as under:-

Costume	-	20
Theme	-	20
Harmony	-	20
Melody	-	20
Background Music	-	20

The announcement of Song/Dance should not take more than 15 seconds.

Quiz –

Quiz will be another regular feature of the Social Science Exhibition. The quiz will be conducted in English and the theme will be “**Swami Vivekananda – Life and Achievements**”. It will be in two rounds. The preliminary round will be a written round in which maximum 05 students from every region will participate. The four top scoring teams will qualify for the final round. In the final round the selected team will be represented by two students of the concerned region. The quiz will be verbal with audio visual round.

Skit-

There will be one act play/skit on any theme related to social issues (i.e., issues related to gender, population, health environment, education etc.) and the language will be English and or Hindi. The duration of the skit will be 10 to 12 minutes and this item will be covered on first two days between 6 and 8 pm. The venue Principal should ensure proper light and sound arrangement for the event based on the requirement of the skit. Basic stage material will be provided by the Regional venue Principal. The best skit selected by region will be sponsored for the Nationals.

Division of marks for the event will be as under –

While selecting students the Principal/Incharge teacher should select the students on the suggested guidelines.

1. English/Hindi Debate	-	04 students
2. Quiz	-	02 students
3. Exclusively for Exhibition	-	02 students
4. Skit	-	05 students
5. Group song, dance and having talent and capabilities to assist/contribute in the items 1-4	-	<u>19 students</u>

In no case, the number of students as specified above (32) should exceed nor any extra escort other than specified need be sent. During the evening programme at Lucknow the participants should be encouraged to wear their Regional/State costume, but during Exhibition school uniform will be the dress code. The children will be taken for local sight seeing also.

The Social Science Exhibition MUST be held at School, Cluster and Regional Level. Selection of students, team and exhibits must be made judiciously, parents, neighboring schools, important local personalities be invited for the Exhibition being organized at School, Cluster and Regional level. The Social Science Exhibition at all levels must be conducted with enthusiasm and earnestness, so that the aim and objective of the event is fully realized.
